

SUPPORT STAFF COACHES AIDE

1. The head coach of any sport shall be responsible for the operation and conduct of all phases of that sport and shall be in charge of all aides and other coaches in the coaching of that sport.
2. The head coach shall be responsible for the following:
 - a. Make certain that all practices are followed by a prepared practice schedule prepared by the head coach.
 - b. Make certain that the aide follows the practice schedule and does not initiate or change the instructions given by the head coach. The aide must carry out the specific instructions given by the head coach.
 - c. Shall cover all safety measures involving the development of the athletes in practice and contests.
 - d. Shall cover all rules and regulations pertaining to the athletic program with the aide.
3. The coaches' aide shall be responsible for the following:
 - a. To assist in starting, executing and completing the specific plan of the learning experience as defined and directed by the head coach.
 - b. For the authority and obligation to correct any improper conduct or behavior of students both in practice and in contests.
 - c. To be specifically prepared and qualified for the duties assigned including emergency situations which might arise in the course of his or her work.
 - d. To provide proper supervision of students during the times he/she is working with students.
 - e. Shall carry out assignments as designated by the head coach of the particular sport.
 - f. Shall be responsible to assist in providing the opportunity for all students in the activity to practice in competition the skills taught, learned and developed as specified in policy of participating in each regularly scheduled contest below the varsity level.
 - g. Shall adhere to all NSAA regulations.
