1. Good News Report
 - a. Congratulations to state track qualifiers Kaylee Palmieri (800 meter run), Miranda Smith (high jump), Jade Bentley (triple jump), Kaylee Palmieri, Jade Bentley, Maliyah Rivera, and Miranda Smith (3200 meter relay), and Nathan Holcomb (1600 meter and 3200 meter runs). Medaling with a 5th place finish was the 3200 meter relay participants and Nathan Holcomb placing 6th in the 3200 meter run.
 - b. The weight room opened May 30th. Sessions for all interested students are Monday through Friday from 6:00 to 9:00 a.m. This session is supervised by the football and volleyball coaching staff members. An evening session, supervised by the football coaching staff, is offered from 7:00 to 9:00 p.m.
 - c. The football team participated in the team camp June 8-10. The team is presently participating in the UNK full contact camp that began on June 11th and will conclude on the 13th. On June 29th the team will travel to Sutton for a one-day camp. On July 5th and 6th Gibbon will be the host site the Central Nebraska Football Jamboree. This will be the 8th annual. On July 15th and July 22nd approximately 20 players will participate in the KCHS passing league.
 - d. The volleyball team is participating in weights, conditioning, and open gym Monday through Friday this summer when not travelling to camps. The team camp was held May 30th through June 2nd. The centers attended a camp on June 9th at Nebraska Wesleyan. On July 6th the girls will be participating in a team camp in Minden. The JV team will participate in a camp on July 7th and 8th at Nebraska Wesleyan. The entire team will attend a team camp at Adam Central on July 13th. The varsity will attend team camp July 17th through the 19th at Ogallala. The freshman will attend a team camp at KCHS on July 20th.
 - e. The Gibbon Alumni Volleyball Tournament was held June 10th and 11th. This tournament included women’s teams as well as coed teams.
 - f. The XC coaching staff is coordinating conditioning for any student at 7:30 a.m. Monday through Friday. Each weekend there is an opportunity for road races in which the student may register for individually. On August 12th the team will be sponsoring a 5K run/walk as part of Gibbon’s Brick Festival activities.
 - g. The girls’ basketball team held their summer camp June 5th – June 9th. Summer league in Kearney is being held Monday evenings in the month of June. Open gym is being held on Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. and on Thursday evening from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. through July 12th. No Thursday sessions in the month of July due to volleyball camps.
