BOARD COMMITTEES

The President of the board shall, at the beginning of each school year appoint three members to the Americanism committee whose duties shall be:

- 1. Examine, inspect, and approve all textbooks used in the teaching of American History and Government;
- 2. Carry out all other responsibilities as required by law.

<u>Special Committees</u>: The President of the board shall have the authority to appoint temporary committees from time to time as the need for such committees arise. These appointments shall be subject to the approval of the board.
