

## **DUNCAN E. MCGREGOR & LILLIAN M. MCGREGOR SCHOLARSHIPS**

- Amount:** \$1,500 (Multiple Awards)
- Eligibility:** Current graduating senior or former graduate of high schools in Ansley, Arcadia, Gibbon, Ord, Sargent, or Shelton High Schools in Nebraska.
- Criteria:** Scholastic achievement in high school or college, financial need.

The Duncan E. McGregor & Lillian M. McGregor Scholarships were established at the Lincoln Community Foundation to benefit students from six communities in central Nebraska. Duncan E. and Lillian McGregor worked and prospered in central Nebraska. D.E. spent his life in the telecommunications business. In 1923, he bought controlling stock in the Gibbon-Shelton Telephone Company which eventually became the Nebraska Central Telephone Company. In 1936, he married Lillian, a native of Lincoln. She served as the secretary/treasurer for the board of D.E.'s telephone company. D.E. passed away in 1980, and Lillian followed him in 1994. Their wish to contribute to the community where they lived and prospered lives on in the hundreds of students who have benefited from this most generous scholarship.

### **CRITERIA**

- 1. Applicant must be a current graduating senior or former graduate of **Ansley, Arcadia, Gibbon, Ord, Sargent, or Shelton High Schools in Nebraska.****
2. Applicant must demonstrate scholastic application and achievement in high school and/or college studies.
3. Applicant must have resided in a community served and maintained by an exchange served by the Nebraska Central Telephone Company during his/her high school education. Those communities are: Ansley, Arcadia, Ashton, Boelus, Burwell, Comstock, Dannebrog, Elba, Ericson, Gibbon, Litchfield, Mason City, North Loup, Ravenna, Rockville, Sargent, Scotia, Shelton and Taylor.
4. Applicant must demonstrate financial need.
5. Those who receive scholarships are eligible to reapply for additional scholarships in subsequent academic years, however preference will be given to current graduating seniors of the six high schools mentioned above.

**APPLICATION**

Applicants are required to complete the Lincoln Community Foundation Application Form online at [www.lcf.org](http://www.lcf.org) and submit the form and all required attachments electronically. Applications must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. on March 15th.

**Application required attachments:**

1. High school or college **transcript(s)** (copies of transcripts are acceptable). High school seniors must submit their high school transcript; high school graduates need only submit their college transcripts.
2. Financial Information that shows **Expected Family Contribution (EFC) number**, which is on the first page of the applicant's Student Aid Report (SAR).

**DEADLINE**

Scholarship applications must be submitted electronically to the Lincoln Community Foundation at [www.lcf.org](http://www.lcf.org) by 11:59 p.m. on March 15th.

**AWARD**

Local scholarship committees at each school will recommend recipients from their school to the Lincoln Community Foundation. The Foundation will make the final selection of scholarship recipients.

Scholarship checks will be sent directly to the student's college or university. Scholarship grants can be made only to qualified, nonproprietary institutions.

This scholarship shall not be awarded to any immediate or distant member of the Duncan E. and Lillian M. McGregor Family.
