

## **Virgil and Darlene Roush Scholarships**

- Amount:** \$450 (5 awards, one for each school)
- Eligibility:** Current graduating seniors of Gibbon, Grand Island Northwest, Hastings St. Cecilia, Shelton, or Wood River high schools in Nebraska.
- Criteria:** Scholastic achievement in high school, financial need.

The Virgil and Darlene Roush Scholarships were established at the Lincoln Community Foundation to benefit students from five communities in central Nebraska. Virgil received his education in Shelton, Nebraska. He served his country honorably in the Navy during WWII. Virgil and Darlene were married in 1948. Together they built and owned Kingswood Mobile Home Estates in Grand Island, NE. Virgil helped District 74 start Grand Island Northwest High School in 1962. Darlene preceded Virgil in death in 2007. He passed away in 2011. It was their wish to contribute to the community where they lived and prospered.

### **CRITERIA**

1. Applicant must be a current graduating senior of **Gibbon, Grand Island Northwest, Hastings St. Cecilia, Shelton, or Wood River high schools in Nebraska.**
2. Applicant must demonstrate scholastic achievement in high school.
3. Applicant must demonstrate financial need.

### **APPLICATION**

Applicants are required to complete the Lincoln Community Foundation Application Form online at [www.lcf.org](http://www.lcf.org) and submit the form and all required attachments electronically. Applications must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. on March 15th.

#### **Application required attachments:**

1. High school **transcript(s)** (copies of transcripts are acceptable).
2. Financial Information that shows **Expected Family Contribution (EFC) number**, which is on the first page of the applicant's Student Aid Report (SAR).

**AWARD**

Local scholarship committees at each school will recommend recipients from their school to the Lincoln Community Foundation. The Foundation will make the final selection of scholarship recipients.

Scholarship checks will be sent directly to the student's college or university. Scholarship grants can be made only to qualified, nonproprietary institutions.
