Scholarship Application

The Gibbon Boosters scholarship is available to those athletes planning to continue their education beyond high school. The criteria below are required in order to apply for the scholarship. The number of scholarships and the amounts given may vary from year to year but typically two \$500.00 scholarships are awarded.

How to apply:

- Applications are available through the high school guidance office and website.
- Please attach your resume to this form. All answers to the application questions should be numbered, typed, and in an envelope with this signed form, your resume, and the personal recommendation.
- Scholarships will be awarded to the individuals who most clearly demonstrate strength in the areas of leadership, sportsmanship, dedication to a sport and team, and service to Gibbon Public Schools and to the community.
- The scholarships will be awarded with consideration to qualifications and not gender.

Requirements for applying:

- Athlete must be a graduating senior of Gibbon Public Schools and plan on attending college or technical school.
- Athlete must have a minimum 2.5 Grade Point Average.
- A letter of recommendation is required.

Please return completed application to the high school guidance office by March 29, 2018 at 3:30 p.m. Late applications will not be accepted.

2. Community Service:

Please list all community service projects and hours you have completed during your high school career.

3. Work Experience:

Please list any jobs you have held during your time at Gibbon High School. Please list where you worked, your position, the month and year you started working there as well as the year and month you stopped working there.

4. Personal Recommendation:

Please list the name and title of the person submitting your letter of recommendation. This recommendation needs to be in a sealed envelope to be kept confidential.

5. Personal Statement:

Please write a short narrative answering following question. (600 words or less)

- How have you demonstrated positive leadership and what life lessons have you learned during your athletic career?

6. College Plan:

Where are you planning to attend college and what is your planned major? (brief statement)
