

## COMPUTER INTERNET USAGE AGREEMENT

The use of the account/access must be consistent with the educational objectives of the Gibbon Public Schools. Use of electronic resources for recreational games is prohibited.

To transmit, download, knowingly receive or have on your home directory any materials in violation of any federal, state or School regulations is prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to the following: copyrighted material, threatening, harassing, pornographic, obscene, or profane material, materials related to the illegal use or manufacture of restricted substances, defamatory or discriminatory material, or material protected by trade secret.

Commercial activities, product advertising, political lobbying and extensive personal use are prohibited. Users are prohibited from personalizing school computers.

Network etiquette-You are expected to abide by the generally accepted rules of network etiquette. These include, but are not limited to: 1) being polite, 2) use of appropriate language, 3) treating network, computer hardware as school property, removing outdated, unneeded files, 4) emailing before or after school unless under teacher instruction.

Computers, files, communications may be accessed and reviewed by District personnel and may be accessed by other users. District personnel can remove files deemed inappropriate for the Gibbon Schools network.

Students who access restricted items on the Internet shall be subject to the following consequences in addition to the consequences published in the point matrix for “unauthorized use of technological devices”:

First Offense — loss of Internet access for up to three weeks

Second Offense — loss of Internet access for one month

Third Offense — loss of Internet access for the remainder of the school year.
