

SENIOR HONOR STUDENTS

Seniors whose grade points average puts them in the top fifteen percent of their class will be recognized with a medallion that will be worn during the graduation ceremony. The student(s) with the highest grade point average, as determined by the 4.0 scale, will be recognized as the valedictorian and honored with a medallion that denotes this honor, a certificate and his/her name posted on the Valedictorian/Salutatorian plaque. The student(s) with the second highest grade point average will be recognized as the salutatorian and honored with a medallion that denotes this honor, a certificate and his/her name posted on the Valedictorian /Salutatorian plaque. Students who are eligible for valedictorian/salutatorian must have attended Gibbon Public School for three full semesters during the junior and senior year. To be recognized in the top 15%, students must have attended Gibbon Public Schools their entire senior year.
