

ACADEMIC ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTRA-CURRICULAR PERFORMANCES

Academic eligibility for students to participate in public performances for the school year will be determined using the following Gibbon School District guidelines as well as the NSAA guidelines. Any student who failed two or more classes in the spring semester of the preceding school year will be ineligible for the first term of the first semester. Eligibility for the second term of the first semester will be determined by first semester mid-term grades (reported on 10/22/18 @ 8am). Eligibility for the first term of the second semester will be determined by first semester grades (reported on 12/21/18 @ 4pm). Eligibility for the second term of the second semester will be determined by second semester mid-term grades (3/11/19 @ 8am). 7th grade students and students new to the district will be eligible for a period of time until which these students receive either a mid-term or a semester grade.

Students who are ineligible may still practice with the team, but will not perform and will not miss class to travel with the team in school-provided transportation. Student managers failing any class will not miss class to travel.
